- English would be the preferred language for the presentation.
- Presentation needs to be submitted in pdf format and in readable format. Limit file size to of presentation 30MB or less. Label your presentation with First name and last name.
- Submit your presentation at least 15 days before the conference to **dementia@stripeconferences.com**, also suggest you carry your presentation on a hard disk or pen drive.
- Equipment is available in the meeting room digital projector, screen, laptop, slider with pointer, mike, and basic sound system.

Certification

- Each participant will receive certificate from chair or co-chair of session at the end of the conference

Poster presentation guidelines

- Poster presentation size need to be in 1.2 meters high by 1.8 meters wide
- All the poster presentation needs to mount on the walls 1 hour prior to the start time of poster sessions as per the final program.
